
St. John Nepomucene Cemetery Regulations

Thank you for your thoughtfulness to decorate and adorn your loved one's grave, and for helping us keep the grounds looking clean and neat for our visitors. Below are our grounds regulations, which will allow our staff to do their tasks efficiently and safely. For more information, please visit our website at stjn.org/cemetery.

1. Decorations shall be in appropriate urns or in pots in approved bracket attached to the monument.
2. Shepherd hooks or anything sticking in the ground (foil balloons, statuettes, solar lights, etc.) in front of the monument are not allowed.
3. All spring and summer decorations must be removed by October 15.
4. All fall and winter decorations must be removed by April 15.
5. Glass containers are not permitted.
6. No trees, shrubs or plants may be planted on grave sites.
7. New grave bouquets may be left on the grave site for 30 days.
8. The Cemetery Association reserves the right to remove and discard all decorations that are out-of-place or distasteful.
9. The only items allowed at the Columbarium Sites is the
