## 2026 4K-8 Summer School Course Descriptions

- Classes run from June 8 - June 26 (8:00 am - 12:00 pm)
- Classes are held in the 5-12 building, **drop off/pick up at Flex Academy doors on Meulemans Ave.**
- Jumpstart 4K & Kindergarten runs from August 10 - August 21 at Little Chute Elementary School
- Jumpstart 5th Grade runs from August 17 - August 19 in the 5-12 building

Course Name	Course Description
<b>Baseball Basics</b>	Baseball Basics will teach the fundamentals of the game. Ballplayers will develop their hitting, fielding, throwing, and base-running skills through a mix of drills and games while emphasizing the importance of teamwork and sportsmanship. Ballplayers should bring their own helmet, bat, glove, and water.
<b>Basketball for All</b>	Basketball for All will teach the fundamentals of the game. We will focus on developing dribbling, passing, and shooting skills in a fun and enjoyable environment. We will also work with helping the students to always give their best effort both on and off the court.
<b>Biking for Beginners</b>	Learn bicycle safety, maintenance, and etiquette, enjoy easy-to-moderate bike trips, and learn how to navigate the local roads, sidewalks, and trails in Little Chute and in the surrounding communities. We will bike to area parks and attractions and stop to enjoy a hike, game of soccer, kickball, or capture the flag. We'll maintain a pace of 6-10 miles per hour with an adult at the front and end of the bike line. <b>REQUIRED: A bicycle in safe working condition, helmet, and refillable water bottle.</b>
<b>Biking for Experts</b>	This course is designed for students who enjoy biking and are ready to build endurance for longer rides. Students will learn how to ride safely and efficiently over extended distances while developing stamina, pacing, and mental focus. Instruction includes proper riding posture, gear use, hydration and nutrition basics, route planning, and bike maintenance for long rides. <b>REQUIRED: A bicycle in safe working condition, helmet, and refillable water bottle.</b>
<b>Bookin', Cookin', Craftin', &amp; Fun</b>	Get ready for a hands-on adventure filled with creativity, cooking, and fun! In this class, students will explore simple cooking and baking activities while also diving into exciting craft projects. Each day, kids will mix, measure, create, and take home their delicious treats or handmade crafts. With access to a kitchen and plenty of crafting supplies, this class is perfect for young chefs and artists who love to learn by doing.
<b>Builders Club Service Project</b>	Students work together to plan and complete service projects that help their school and community. Through teamwork and leadership, students learn the importance of helping others and making a positive difference.
<b>Coloring, Puzzles &amp; Moving</b>	Each class integrates activities that balance creativity, problem-solving, and movement to keep young learners excited and engaged. Students can expect to complete individual, small group, and whole class projects/tasks while solving problems together and getting plenty of movement in throughout the time together.

<b>Crafts to Make &amp; Take</b>	Unleash your creativity in this hands-on crafting adventure! Students will explore a variety of art and crafting techniques to create unique, take-home projects. From colorful beadwork to DIY bookmarks, fun creations, and personalized items, this class is packed with engaging activities that allow students to express themselves while building fine motor skills and artistic confidence. All materials are provided—just bring your imagination!
<b>Couch to 2.5K</b>	This summer school fitness course is designed for students with little to no running experience who want to build endurance, confidence, and healthy exercise habits. Through a gradual “couch to 2.5K” training plan, students will learn how to safely progress from walking and light jogging to running up to 2.5 kilometers without stopping. By the end of the course, students will be able to complete a 2.5K run or jog-walk at their own pace and will have the tools to continue running safely and independently.
<b>Crime Scene Investigation</b>	Does your child love a good mystery? Students will use scientific methods, inference, and other tools to solve crimes/mysteries. Students will learn to be good witnesses/observers and investigators while solving crimes.
<b>Fabulous Friendships</b>	What better way for your child to spend the summer than with friends? In this class, we will be exploring everything around friendships. How can we make friends, be good friends, handle friendship troubles, and learn ways to be friends in our community? We will practice these skills through books, fun board and sports games, arts and crafts projects, and come up with project ideas to spread friendship throughout our community.
<b>Game Makers: STEAM Adventures</b>	Dive into the exciting world of game creation with "Game Makers: STEAM Adventures"! In this innovative course, students will combine Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math to design and build their own games. By the end of the course, students will walk away with unique, playable games they can share with family and friends. Get ready for an adventure in imagination and discovery!
<b>Games Galore</b>	Welcome to "Games Galore," where every day is a new adventure in fun and games! This course offers a variety of indoor and outdoor activities, including team games, individual challenges, board games, card games, and more. Whether you're strategizing in a game of checkers, competing in a relay race, or collaborating in a group scavenger hunt, there's something for everyone. Build teamwork, sharpen problem-solving skills, and most importantly, have a blast! Come ready to play, explore, and enjoy the ultimate game experience.
<b>Intro to Forensics</b>	Join us to learn about the art of public speaking through Forensics! Students learn to speak clearly and confidently in front of others through speeches, storytelling, and group activities. The class focuses on building confidence, good listening skills, and respectful communication.
<b>Jumpstart 4K</b>	A shortened version of a typical 4K day including story time, art time, play, snack, and playground time. Our weekly themes will be Getting to Know You, Summer Fun, and ABC-123! Two-course options are available for those students entering 4K in the fall.

<b>Jumpstart Kindergarten</b>	Getting students ready for Kindergarten! Each day includes a learning activity, read-aloud, and snack revolving around a fun, age-appropriate theme. There will be additional enrichment and recess time. There are two options for those entering 5k in the fall.
<b>Jumpstart 5th Grade</b>	Getting students ready for 5th Grade! Students will get acquainted with the Intermediate School, meet new friends, learn protocols and procedures for 5th grade, and meet one of their teachers. There are two options for those entering 5th grade in the fall.
<b>Legos &amp; More</b>	Build, imagine, and discover! <i>Legos and More</i> is a hands-on summer course designed for students in grades 1–4 who love to create and explore. Using LEGO® bricks and a variety of building materials, students will design structures, solve fun challenges, and bring their ideas to life.
<b>Make, Take &amp; Learn</b>	Get ready for a fun-filled class where creativity and learning come together! In "Make, Take, and Learn," students will enjoy hands-on activities that combine crafting with educational themes. Each day brings a new project, from building paper planes to creating puzzles, and more. Along the way, students will practice key skills like counting, letter recognition, and problem-solving—all while making projects they can proudly take home.
<b>Math 1-8</b>	Students must be recommended for this course. This class has been specially designed to meet the needs of students who need more time learning math than the school year can provide. This math class will be limited so that the focus can be on individual learning needs.
<b>Math Workshop</b>	This course engages young learners in building foundational math skills through hands-on activities, games, and collaborative learning. Each class will include a mix of instruction, practice, and fun activities to reinforce key concepts.
<b>Movies, Books &amp; Projects</b>	Immerse yourself in the world of storytelling with "Movies, Books, and Projects"! In this engaging course, students will explore popular books and their movie adaptations, comparing how stories come to life on the screen and the page. The course will include discussions, film reviews and enjoyment, and occasional hands-on activities inspired by the stories. This class combines the magic of literature and cinema with imaginative fun—perfect for curious minds and budding creators!
<b>Movies &amp; Friends</b>	In this fun and engaging class, students will watch age-appropriate movies and explore their themes through lively discussions. From friendship and teamwork to kindness and adventure, students will share their thoughts and connect with characters on screen. Occasionally, they will also enjoy snacks while watching. This class encourages conversation, creativity, and social interaction in a relaxed and enjoyable setting!
<b>Mustang Youth Chorus</b>	Join us for an exciting musical journey where we'll explore the fundamentals of singing and reading music! Students will work together to prepare a few songs for a fun and impromptu concert to showcase their talents. Along the way, we'll set personal goals, develop warm-up and practice routines, and discover ways to keep growing as musicians throughout the summer.

<b>Mustang Theater Academy</b>	<p><b>Acting Section, 3rd-6th Grade</b> - As an extension of the Little Chute Theater Department, students will have the opportunity to get involved in a musical theater production of <i>Frozen Kids Edition</i>.</p> <p><b>Production Section, 7th-12th Grade</b> - Middle and High School students will learn how to produce a theater production. They will mentor young actors as they learn and perform <i>Frozen Kids Edition</i>.</p>
